The Blended Intensive Programme “Bloomberg Lab” gives students practical insight into financial markets using the Bloomberg Terminal. It combines theory with hands-on analysis of financial data, market trends, and financial instruments. Students learn to use Bloomberg for data retrieval, company and market analysis, and data-driven decision-making.

The programme includes lectures, workshops, and teamwork in international groups, focusing on financial statements, macroeconomic indicators, and investment or strategic recommendations.

It consists of a virtual preparation phase and an intensive on-site part, with mentoring and a final team presentation.

The aim is to develop practical analytical skills and the ability to make informed decisions in real financial market conditions.

OSIJEK, EFOS, 07 – 11 DECEMBER 2026

Financial Markets Analysis and Data-Driven Decision-Making provides insight into global financial markets and the use of professional financial information systems.

The programme covers key topics such as financial market analysis, financial statement interpretation, macroeconomic indicators, and data-driven decision-making using the Bloomberg Terminal.

Through a combination of virtual and physical mobility, participants develop analytical, problem-solving, and teamwork skills while gaining hands-on experience with industry-standard tools in an international learning environment.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Develop skills in Bloomberg Terminal navigation and data extraction.
- Perform industry benchmarking and competitor analysis.
- Improve the ability to make data-driven decisions under uncertainty and time constraints.
- Strengthen teamwork, communication, and problem-solving skills in an international and interdisciplinary environment.
- Enhance analytical and critical thinking skills through mentoring, feedback, and reflection.
